

Addendum to an Existing Contract
ARPA SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT
BOARD OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
And
Town of Luther

THIS CONTRACT ADDENDUM is in reference to a contract agreement dated 08/21/2024 between the Board of Oklahoma County Commissioners, herein referred to as COUNTY, and the Town of Luther, herein referred to as SUBRECIPIENT.

THAT WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the SUBRECIPIENT have entered into an agreement for SUBRECIPIENT for the provision of ARPA funding for facilities managed by the SUBRECIPIENT.

- The Luther Fire Department plays a crucial role in maintaining public safety and providing emergency services to the community. Their functions include fire prevention, fire suppression, emergency medical services, and various other public safety duties.
- Beyond their immediate emergency response duties, the Luther Fire Department plays a vital role in supporting the community. They participate in local events, assist with disaster preparedness efforts, respond to natural disasters, and collaborate with other emergency services to enhance overall public safety.

A copy of the original contract is made part of this Addendum;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to reduce the terms of this Amendment to writing;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises to each other, as hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto do mutually agree to the contract addendum as follows:

1. **Reference: The “not-to-exceed amount”**
 - For the additional services as outlined, COUNTY shall provide financial assistance to the SUBRECIPIENT in an additional amount not to exceed \$39,843.80. The not-to-exceed amount is being increased by \$39,843.80 from \$375,000.00 to **\$414,843.80**.
2. **Reference ATTACHMENT B2: 20043: PROJECT DETAILS: Safety Equipment and Services for Emergency Response Personal: Firefighters**
 - The not-to-exceed increase of \$39,843.80 is being provided by COUNTY to SUBRECIPIENT for the procurement of Face Masks, Respirators, and other safety equipment and services so the Luther Fire Department may effectively perform their duties while minimizing risks to their health and well-being.
 - Safety services may include, but are not limited to:
 - Training
 - Equipment Maintenance
 - Health Monitoring
 - Incident Command Systems
 - Decontamination Services

May it be known that the undersigned parties, for good consideration, do hereby agree to make the following changes and / or additions that are outlined within the addendum. These additions shall be made valid as if they are included in the original stated contract.

No other terms or conditions of the SUBRECIPIENT contract shall be negated or changed as a result of this here stated addendum.

All promises, requirements, terms, conditions, provisions, representations contained and specified in the original Agreement shall survive and become part of this Addendum unless specifically provided otherwise herein, or unless superseded by applicable Federal law or State statutes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the SUBRECIPIENT and the COUNTY respectively, have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.
