WHEREAS, currently, the organization develops leadership skills and finds ways through volunteering to strengthen the community to produce a higher standard of living and a better way of life for all its citizens and

WHEREAS, one-hundred and fifteen years later, the Oklahoma County OHCE members are still serving their community. In 2024, they donated around 22,000 hours of service to organizations such as Oklahoma Veterans Medical Center, the Juvenile Detention Center, Grandparents Raising Grandchildren, Oklahoma Literacy Coalition, and the Oklahoma Mental Health Association; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma County OHCE recognizes their great responsibility toward Oklahoma families and continues to safeguard the primary ideals of family life;

WHEREAS, Oklahoma County OHCE provides a healthy outlet for its 8 groups and over 90 members to reach out to others in their communities through personal service and education; and
