

**Addendum to an Existing Contract**  
**ARPA SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT**  
**BOARD OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**  
**And**  
**Mid-Del Youth and Family Center, Inc.**

THIS CONTRACT ADDENDUM is in reference to a contract agreement dated 09/26/2024 between the Board of Oklahoma County Commissioners, herein referred to as COUNTY, and the Mid-Del Youth and Family Center, Inc, herein referred to as SUBRECIPIENT.

THAT WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the SUBRECIPIENT have entered into an agreement for SUBRECIPIENT for the provision of ARPA funding for projects managed by the SUBRECIPIENT.

- Mid-Del Youth and Family Center is a non-profit that helps youth and families in their greatest time of need, regardless of their ability to pay. They offer counseling, prevention services, domestic violence advocacy and an emergency shelter for youth.

A copy of the original contract is made part of this Addendum;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to reduce the terms of this Amendment to writing;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises to each other, as hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto do mutually agree to the contract addendum as follows:

1. **Reference: The “not-to-exceed amount”**
  - For the additional services as outlined, COUNTY shall provide financial assistance to the SUBRECIPIENT in an additional amount not to exceed \$100,000.00. The not-to-exceed amount is being increased by \$100,000.00 from \$100,000.00 to **\$200,000.00**.
2. **Reference ATTACHMENT B1: 30237: PROJECT DETAILS: Mid-Del Youth and Family Center, Inc: Stay Safe and Connected Program**
  - The not-to-exceed increase of \$100,000.00 is being provided by COUNTY to SUBRECIPIENT for their ongoing efforts for the Stay Safe and Connected Program.
  - The “Stay Safe & Connected” program will work with local law enforcement agencies and victim advocates to provide victims with telephones and phone service after leaving an abusive relationship. It is known that many abusers will track their partner’s phones or destroy them when an abused person leaves or seeks help.
  - Specifically, the “Stay Safe & Connected” program will provide individual law enforcement agencies or advocates with phones that could be activated to provide a victim in an emergency room or law enforcement agency in real-time to meet a need of staying connected. If the victim qualifies for federally subsidized Lifeline service, they would later be enrolled in that program. If the victim does not, grant funds will cover up to six months of telephone service for the victim if they cannot otherwise afford to pay for the service.

May it be known that the undersigned parties, for good consideration, do hereby agree to make the following changes and / or additions that are outlined within the addendum. These additions shall be made valid as if they are included in the original stated contract.

No other terms or conditions of the SUBRECIPIENT contract shall be negated or changed as a result of this here stated addendum.

All promises, requirements, terms, conditions, provisions, representations contained and specified in the original Agreement shall survive and become part of this Addendum unless specifically provided otherwise herein, or unless superseded by applicable Federal law or State statutes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the SUBRECIPIENT and the COUNTY respectively, have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.
