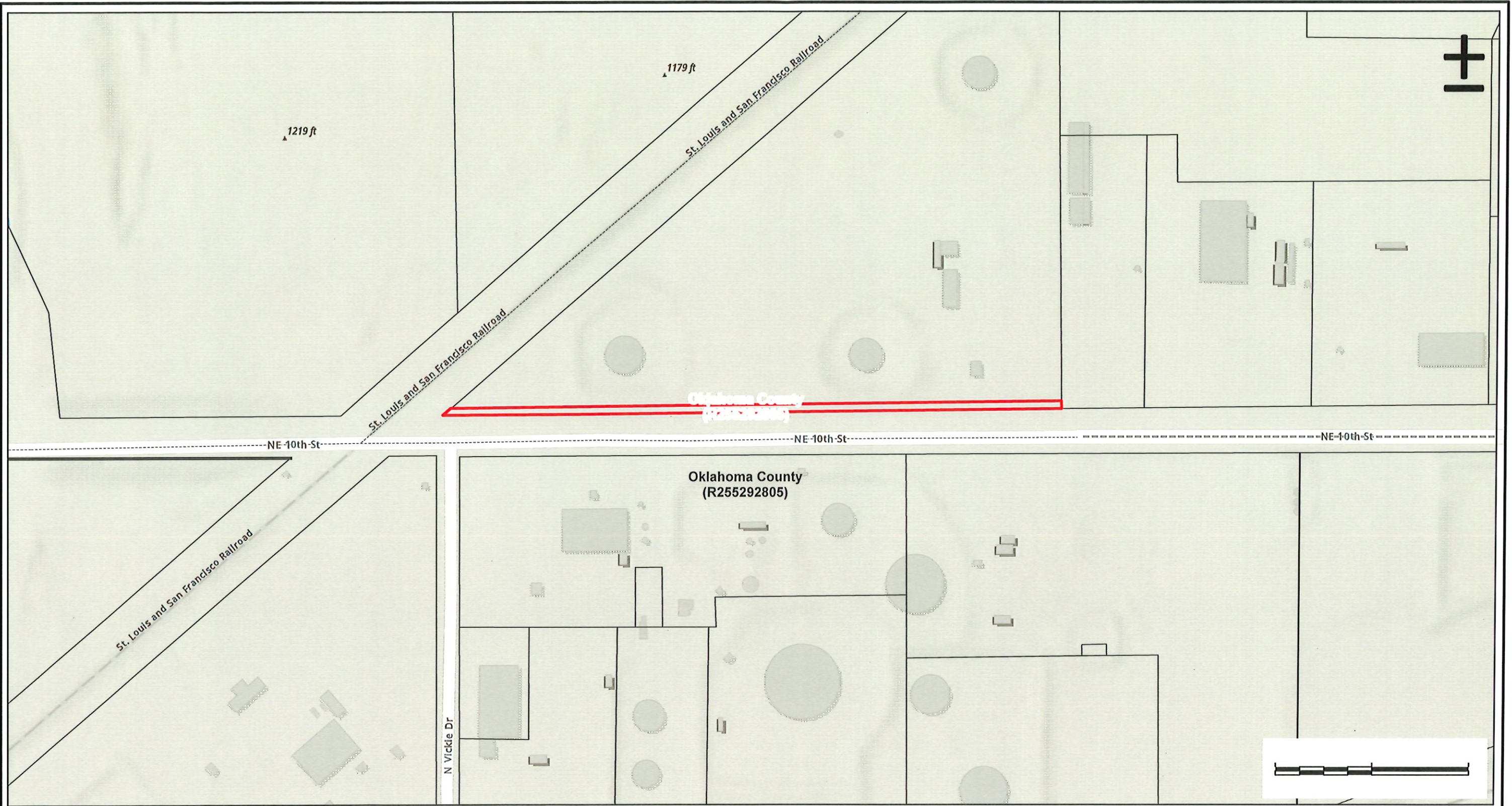





Dear Ms. Trumbo:

This letter is to request the Oklahoma County Board of County Commissioners (Board) concurrence for placing a Land Use Covenant on the deed record for Parcel 2514-25-529-2805. Phillips 66 Company has been cleaning up a hydrocarbon spill originating from the Phillips 66 Oklahoma City Terminal that occurred in 1992. As you are aware, trace amounts of hydrocarbon contamination in groundwater have migrated to the subject property. The Oklahoma Corporation Commission (OCC), the State regulatory agency overseeing the cleanup effort, has agreed that the effort has been sufficient provided shallow groundwater in the vicinity of Terminal is not used. There are currently no water wells in the vicinity of the Terminal because public water is supplied by the City of Del City. Regardless, the OCC requests that shallow groundwater use be restricted in the vicinity as a preventative measure against future use. Based on this, Phillips 66 wishes to place a groundwater use restriction on the subject property.

A draft deed restriction is attached for your consideration. Additionally, a draft letter of concurrence is attached for completion so Phillips 66 can provide the OCC with documentation of property owner concurrence. If requested, we can provide additional background information regarding Site cleanup efforts.
