**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PARTICIPATION IN  
SIX REMNANT DEFENDANTS  
NATIONAL OPIOID SETTLEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, pharmaceutical opioids have harmed Oklahoma County, Oklahoma and its citizens. This harm was created and exacerbated by the misconduct and illegal activities of six (6) regional distributors/dispenser Remnant Defendants: (1) Associated Pharmacies, Inc. (and American Associated Pharmacies), (2) J M Smith Corporation, (3) Morris and Dickson Co., L.L.C., (4) Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., (5) North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., and (6) United Natural Foods, Inc. (including its subsidiaries SuperValu and Advantage Logistics) collectively (“Six Remnant Defendants”).

**WHEREAS**, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma filed suit to address and seek recovery for the harms caused to it and its citizens.

**WHEREAS**, Oklahoma County’s participation in the Six Remnant Defendants Settlement, will result in a one-time settlement payment to Oklahoma County, OK. The Settlement funds must be used for the Core Strategies and Approved Uses set forth in Exhibit D of the Six Remnant Defendant Settlement Agreement. There is one settlement agreement covering the combined settlement with the Six Remnant Defendants.

**THEREFORE**, it was duly moved and seconded that the following resolution be adopted.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Oklahoma County, Oklahoma hereby elects to participate, and hereby approves its participation in, the Six Remnant Defendants National Opioid Settlement Agreement, with regional distributors/dispenser Remnant Defendants: (1) Associated Pharmacies, Inc. (and American Associated Pharmacies), (2) J M Smith Corporation, (3) Morris and Dickson Co., L.L.C., (4) Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., (5) North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., and (6) United Natural Foods, Inc. (including its subsidiaries SuperValu and Advantage Logistics), and authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to execute the Subdivision Participation Form in the Six Remnant Defendants National Opioid Settlement (including executing such Participation Form electronically or via wet ink), and agrees to the terms set forth in the Participation Form.

The Board of County Commissioners of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma adopted the above Resolution on this 8<sup>th</sup> Day of **April, 2026**.
