SPECIFIC INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

Between Oklahoma County and Deer Creek Fire Department

Authority

This Agreement is entered into pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Title 74 O.S. §1001 et seq., allowing political subdivisions to cooperate in governmental functions.

Purpose

Oklahoma County will provide labor and equipment for site improvements to Deer Creek Fire Department property. The Fire Department will pay for all materials.

Scope of Work

The County will provide grading, hauling, placement of materials, and related work as mutually agreed to rough grade and install materials for preparation of the site for Deer Creek Fire Station #3.

Materials

The Fire Department shall pay for all materials. Estimated material cost: \$22,000.

Labor and Equipment

Oklahoma County shall provide labor and equipment at no cost to the Fire Department. Estimated Cost: \$100,000.

Term

This Agreement shall remain in effect until June 30, 2026. This agreement can be renewed if the project is not completed by this date.

Liability

Each party shall be responsible for its own acts and omissions under the Oklahoma Governmental Tort Claims Act.
