WHEREAS, 69 O.S. § 601A, authorizes the County to use any funds which are in the county highway fund to construct and maintain as county highways those roads which best serve the most people of the county; and

WHEREAS, the County and the OTA find that it is to the mutual benefit of the citizens of both the OTA and the County to enter into an agreement for mutual cooperation of maintenance, construction, and repair of certain streets within the limits of the OTA and the responsibility of the County, and the maintenance for safe travels within the limits of the County's jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The County may, at their discretion, construct, install and maintain, on the property shown in Attachment A, a salt and sand storage facility at no cost to the OTA.
