SAAS SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Saas Sorvices Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into offective as of July 1, 2022 (the "Bifective Date") between hist Appraised Inc., with a place of husiness at 2261 Market Street #4074 San Francisco CA, 94114 ("Company"), and the undersigned Customer ("Customer").

BACKGROUND

- A. Company provides a sales verification software-as-a-service application that aggregates various data sources about real estate transactions and creates a workflow that is designed to allow staff members to process real estate sales mere quickly (collectively the "Pintform").
- B. Company also provides support and maintenance services related to its Platform, and may offer consulting, implementation and other professional services.
- C. Customer wishes to utilize the Platform and related services as provided herola.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

PLATFORM ACCESS.

- 1.1 Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Company hereby greats Customer and its Users a non-exclusive, non-transferable (except for permitted assignments under Section 9) right, during the Term (as defined below), to access and use the Platform solely for Customer's internal business purposes to accordance with the applicable Order Porm. As used hereby, "User" means an employee, representative, consultant, contractor or agent of Customer who is authorized to use the Platform and has been supplied a user identification and password by Customer (or by Company at Customer's request).
- 1.2 As used herein, "Order Form" means a quote, order form in substantially the form attached as Exhibit A, or other ordering document detailing the Customer's access to the Platform and any associated fees therefor and any transaction-specific terms and conditions. Upon multial execution (or, in the case of quotes, confirmation and placoment of the order by Customer'), Order Form(s) will be governed by the terms and conditions hereof and are deemed incorporated herein by this reference. If the parties agree, an Order Form may be used in connection with, or in the of, an SOW (as defined below).
- 1.3 As part of the registration process, Customer will identify an administrative user name and password for Customer's Company account. Company reserves the right to refuse registration of, or cancel pusswords it deems inappropriate. Customer may only allow that number of Users as is specified in the applicable Order Forms(s) to use the Platform at any one time. Customer acknowledges that Company may

include in its Platform functionality to track the number of active Users and to disallow use by more than the authorized number of Users. Customer is responsible for all activities that occur under Customer's User accounts. Customer shall use commercially reasonable efforts to prevent unauthorized access to, or use of, the Platform, and shall promptly notify Company of any known unauthorized use. Customer will ensure that (a) all Users given access to the Platform have the right to access the information and Customer Data made accessible to them by Customer through the Platform and (b) any User granting Company access to any Customer Data than the right and authority to grant such access.

Supportand professional services

- 2.1 Subject to the terms hereof, Company will provide Customer with reasonable technical support services in accordance with the Company's standard practice.
- 2.2 In connection with Customer's use of the Platform, Company and Customer may agree in an Order Form and/or a soparate mutually executed Statement of Work (an "SQW") upon training, implementation, consulting or other professional services to be performed by Company (collectively the "Professional Services"). Customer agrees to provide Company with any required Customer materials needed for Company to perform the Professional Services, and hereby grants Company a royalty-free, non-exclusive, worldwide themse to use such unterials for the sole purpose of enabling Company to perform the Professional Services. Company will use commercially reasonable offerts to meet any schedules set forth in an SOW or Order Form, and Customer agrees to cooperate in good fuith to allow Company to achieve completion of such Professional

Services in a timely and professional manner. If achievement of any particular sullextone is dependent upon parformance of lasks by Customer or by a third party outside of Company's control, any projected dates for accomplishing such milestones will be approximately adjusted to reflect any changes in such tasks. Company retains all right, little and interest in and to (i) anything it uses or devolops in connection with performing Professional Services for Customer, including, among other things, software, tools, specifications, ideas, concepts, inventions, processes, techniques, and know-how and (ii) anything it delivers to Customer during the course of performing Professional Services (collectively, "Deliverables") ((I) and (ii) being collectively referred to herein as the "Professional Services IP"), unless otherwise specified in the applicable Order Form or SOW. Company hereby grants to Customer and its Users, a non-oxclusive, unn-transferable (except for permitted assignments under Section 9), worldwide, royally-free, limited-term floors to use the Delivembles during the Term salely in conjunction with Customer's use of the Platform, Customer may not copy, modify, or otherwise oreate derivative works of any Deliverables without Company's prior written consent in each enso.

3. RESTRICTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Customer and its Users will not, directly or indirectly, (i) reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or otherwise attempt to discover the source cade, object code or underlying structure, ideas, know-how or algorithms relevant to the Platform or any software, documentation or data reinted to the Platform ("Software"); (ii) modify, copy, translate, or create derivative works based on the Platform or any Software (except to the extent expressly permitted by Company or authorized within the Platform); (iii) rent, lease, lend, soll, sublicense, assign, distribute, publish, transfer, or otherwise make the Platform available to any third party, except for Users; (iv) use the Plutform to send spam or unsolitated messages, collect data rogarding others without their consent, transmit unlayful, immoral, libelous, lorinous, infringing, defamatory, threatening, rulgar or obscene material or material harmful to minors, transmit viruses or other harmful computer code; (v) attempt to interfere with or disrupt the performance of the Platform or the data contained therein; (vi) attempt to get unauthorized access to the Platform or networks related to the Platform; (vii) interfere with another's use of the Platform; (vill) oreate "links" to or from the Platform, or "frame" or "militor" any of Company's content; (ix) use the Platform in any manner or for any purpose that is uninvent under applicable laws; (x) access the Platform to build a competitive service, reproduce features of the Platform, or rosell the Platform; or (xl) remove any proprietary notices or labels from the Company IP (as defined
- 3.2 Further, Customer may not remove or export from the United States or allow the export or re-export of the Platform, Software or anything related thereto, or any direct product thereof in violation of any restrictions, laws or regulations of the United States Department of Commerce, the United States Department of Treasury Office of Foreign Assets Control, or any

other United States or foreign agency or authority. As defined in PAR section 2.101, the Software and documentation are "commercial items" and according to DFAR section 252.2277014(a)(1) and (5) are deemed to be "commercial computer software" and "commercial computer software" and "commercial computer software documentation." Consistent with DFAR section 227,7202 and PAR section 12.212, any use modification, reproduction, release, performance, display, or disclosure of such commercial software or commercial software documentation by the U.S. Government will be governed softly by the terms of this Agreement and will be prohibited except to the extent expressly permitted by the terms of this Agreement.

- 3.3 Customer represents, covenants, and warrants that Customer will use the Platform only in compliance with Company's standard published policies then in effect (the "Policy") and all applicable laws and regulations, Customer hereby agrees to Indemnify and hold harmless Company against any dentages, losses, Habilities, settlements and expenses (including without limitation oasts and alterneys' fees) in connection with any claim or action that arises from an alleged violation of the foregoing or otherwise from Customer's use of Platform. Although Company has no obligation to monitor Customer's use of the Platform (Company may do so and may prohibit any use of the Platform it believes may be (or alleged to be) in violation of the foregoing.
- 3.4 Customer shall be responsible for obtaining and maintaining any equipment and ancillary services needed to connect to, access or otherwise use the Platform, including, without limitation, moderns, hardware, servers, software, operating systems, networking, web souvers and the like (collectively, "<u>Routoment</u>").  - 4.3 Company shall own and retain all right, fills and interest in and to (a) the Platform and Softwere, all improvements, chancements, derivative works, or modifications thereto, (b) all Professional Services IP, (c) any data that is based on or derived from the Customer Data (including derivative works of the Customer Data), and (d) all intellectual property rights related to any of the foregoing (collectively, the "Company IP").
 - 4.4 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the Company shall have the right to collect and analyze data and other information relating to the provision, use and performance of various aspects of the Platform and Professional Services rendered to Customer and related systems and technologies (including, Customer Data and data derived therefrom), and Company will be free (during and after the Term as applicable) to use and disclose such information and data (a) to improve and enhance the Platform, and (b) for other development, improvement, diagnostic and corrective purposes in connection with providing the Platform and other Company offerings to Customer and to third parties.

Customer will pay in full for the Platform up to and including the last day on which the Platform is provided.
- 6.3 Customer may terminate this Agreement for convenience by providing Company with sixty (60) days written notice. In the event of such a termination, Customer will receive a refund of any prepaid fees for services not yet completed.
- 6.4 Sections 4, 5, 6.4 and 7-9 will survive expiration or termination of this Agreement for any reason.

7. WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMER

Company shall use reasonable efforts consistent with prevailing Industry standards to maintain the Platform in a manner which minimizes errors and interruptions in the Platform and shall perform the Professional Services in a professional and workmanlike manner. The Platform may be temporarily unavailable for schoduled maintenance or for uncoheduled emergency maintenance, other by Company or by third-party

providers, or because of other causes beyond Company's reasonable control, but Company shall use reasonable efforts to provide advance notice in writing or by e-mail of any scheduled service disruption. However, Company Dobs Not Warrant That The Platform Will, Be uninterrupted or error freie, nor does it make any warranty as to the results that may be expressly set porth in this section, the platform and professional services are provided "as is" and company disclaims all warranties, express or implied, including, but not limited to, implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose and non-infringement.
