The approved change order for the expanded area and wall for the Clerks Books did not include additional abatement as required. Cooley received a change order from the abatement contractor MEM for additional charges required by phasing; which already had been agreed to by MEM and Cooley; plus, additional costs. The additional requested amount did include the additional abatement but was extremely high at approximately \$51,000.00 for phasing, inspections, abatement and air monitoring. White rejected the amount along with the County as not representative of the work involved.

Cooley contacted White in the afternoon of July 3rd to advise the new; not to exceed amount; would be \$18,000.00 from MEM/Cooley for the abatement. White told Cooley to proceed with the work with the understanding White would be responsible for the charges or the balance of the charges if the County desired to participate under the definition of added value. The abatement of the asbestos has no impact to schedule.
