Recognizing September as Hunger Action Month in Oklahoma County

WHEREAS, Hunger Action Month is a nationwide campaign led by Feeding America and supported locally by the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma to raise awareness about hunger and inspiring action toward ending food insecurity; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma, local food pantries, faith-based organizations and countless volunteers have demonstrated unwavering commitment to alleviating hunger and ensuring access to healthy, nutritious food; and

WHEREAS, strong public-private partnerships are essential in addressing food insecurity and creating lasting solutions for food security in Oklahoma County; and
