Oklahoma County Home and Community Education Week May 3-9, 2026

***WHEREAS**, this organization began in 1910 and their original goal was to teach farm women in rural Oklahoma better methods for getting their work done, in areas such as gardening, canning, nutrition, and sewing, and to encourage them to improve their families' living conditions; and*

***WHEREAS**, currently, the organization develops leadership skills and finds ways through volunteering to strengthen the community to produce a higher standard of living and a better way of life for all its citizens and*

***WHEREAS**, one hundred and sixteen years later, the Oklahoma County OHCE members are still serving their community. In 2025, they donated over 22,000 hours of service to organizations such as Oklahoma Veterans Medical Center, the Juvenile Detention Center, Grandparents Raising Grandchildren, Project 66 Food & Resource Center, and Pivot, Incorporated; and*
