## Addendum to an Existing Contract

## ARPA SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BOARD OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS And OKLAHOMA COUNTY PUBLIC BUILDINGS AUTHORITY

THIS CONTRACT ADDENDUM is in reference to a contract agreement dated <u>10/30/2024</u> between the Board of Oklahoma County Commissioners, herein referred to as COUNTY, and the Oklahoma County Public Building Authority, herein referred to as SUBRECIPIENT.

THAT WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the SUBRECIPIENT have entered into an agreement for SUBRECIPIENT for the provision of ARPA funding for projects managed by the SUBRECIPIENT.

• The Oklahoma County Public Buildings Authority (PBA) is responsible for management, operations, and maintenance of contracted county facilities. The PBA is charged with providing a safe, comfortable workspace through quality facilities and responsive service at each of their contracted locations.

A copy of the original contract is made part of this Addendum;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to reduce the terms of this Amendment to writing;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises to each other, as hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto do mutually agree to the contract addendum as follows:

## 1. Reference: The "not-to-exceed amount"

- For the additional services as outlined, COUNTY shall provide financial assistance to the SUBRECIPIENT in an additional amount not to exceed \$125,431.79
- Specifically, the Emergency Management Operations Center Krowse project: 10064 is being increased from \$6,168,000.00 to \$6,293,431.79.
- The total contract not-to-exceed amount is being increased from \$16,212,897.82 to \$16,338,329.61.

## 2. Reference Attachment B1: 10064 Project Detail's Emergency Management Operations Center – Krowse

- The not-to-exceed increase of \$125,431.79 is being provided by COUNTY to SUBRECIPIENT for the Emergency Operations Center and its associated cabling, security and contract tracing cameras, and building access control.
- Oklahoma County's Office of Emergency Management ensures comprehensive emergency preparedness and response. During disasters, this office acts as the central hub for operations and coordinates efforts across jurisdictions. The new Emergency Operations Center (EOC) will be a secure, round-the-clock facility, equipped with advanced communication and backup utilities. It will support daily emergency management functions and ensure uninterrupted operations.

May it be known that the undersigned parties, for good consideration, do hereby agree to make the following changes and / or additions that are outlined within the addendum. These additions shall be made valid as if they are included in the original stated contract.

No other terms or conditions of the SUBRECIPIENT contract shall be negated or changed as a result of this here stated addendum.

All promises, requirements, terms, conditions, provisions, representations contained and specified in the original Agreement shall survive and become part of this Addendum unless specifically provided otherwise herein, or unless superseded by applicable Federal law or State statutes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the SUBRECIPIENT and the COUNTY respectively, have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.
