Justice Services – County Community Safety Investment Fund (SQ781)

To Whom It May Concern:

For the FY26 County Community Reinvestment Funding the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS) is striving to make the process easier for counties to receive the dollars the legislature has appropriated while remaining accountable to expenditures and reporting.

Attached you will find a statement of work outlining the new submission process, reporting, deliverables and invoicing. There was a change this year in language within Senate Bill 251 which provides a minimum amount to be allocated.

Per the 2025 Senate Bill 251:

D. The number of awards and funding amounts of each award shall be at the discretion of the Department and shall be based on total available funds, total county population, and the criteria in subsection B of this section. Each county government or multi-county partnership shall be allocated at least half of one percent (0.5%) of the total amount appropriated for the award cycle.

This change does impact the amount allocated to each county as the total FY26 appropriation of \$12,500,000.00 was not changed. If you have not previously accessed FY24 or FY25 funding those dollars remain available for utilization and shall be utilized prior to the current fiscal year funding. Previous fiscal years will not expire but must be used prior to FY26 funds.

FY25: \$226,157.84 (Remaining available)

FY26: \$2,243,563.50

Oklahoma County is in year three (3) of their project period and is receiving a renewal. In FY27 you will need to provide another project/program submission.
