

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-10158**  
**APPROVING COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT BOUNDARIES**

**WHEREAS**, Title 19 section 321 requires a county to be divided into three districts by the Board of County Commissioners as equal in population as practical; and

**WHEREAS**, Title 19 section 321 requires for the purposes of the 2021 reapportionment, the Board will reapportion on or before November 30, 2021, following the official publication of the Federal Decennial Census; and

**WHEREAS**, all boundaries of county commissioner districts shall follow clearly visible, definable and observable physical boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the Voting Rights Act and subsequent court opinions have held that County Commissioner Districts' populations may be within 5% of each other to be in compliance; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commissioner Districts shall have the following populations:  
District 1 = \_\_\_\_\_; District 2 = \_\_\_\_\_;  
District 3 = \_\_\_\_\_ and meet the criteria listed above.
